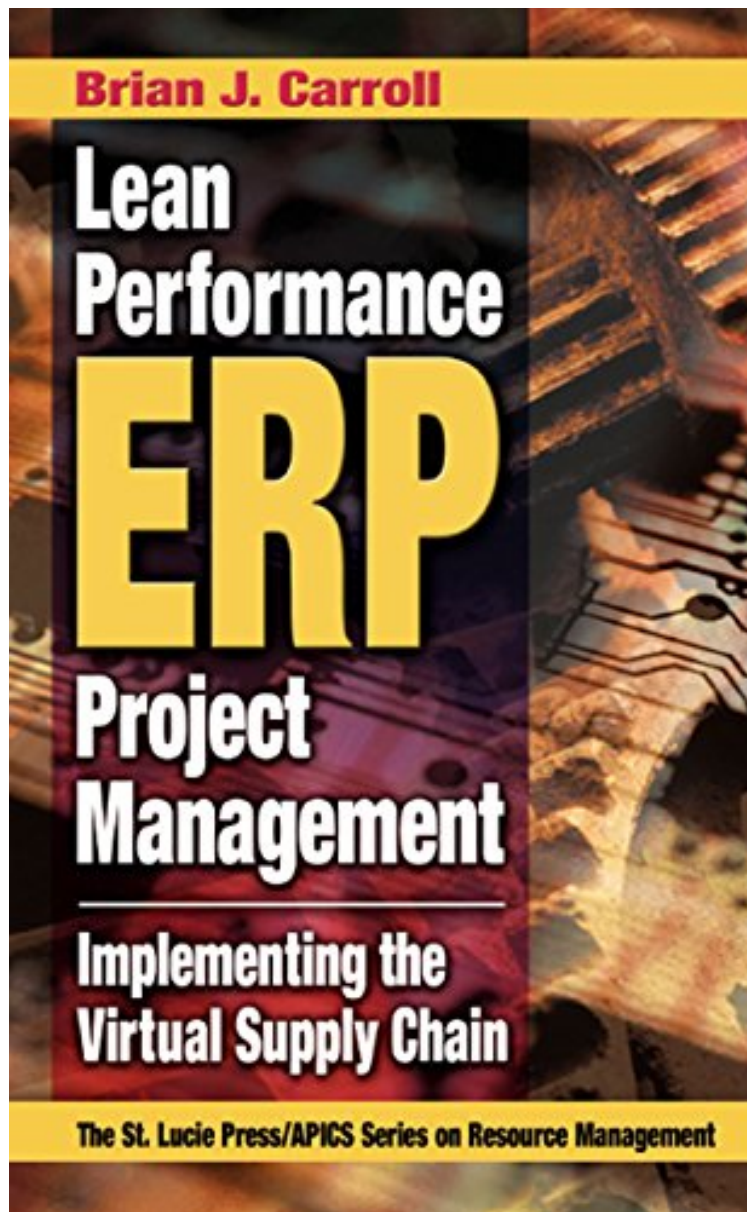


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Lean Performance ERP Project Management: Implementing the Virtual Supply Chain (Resource Management)
